

CSL Report to FOLK Board

September 2017

The June CSL program was Creating and Expanding Your Garden presented by Diana Duff. Total attendance was 24 people, and the calabash donation total was \$32.16.

The July CSL program was Alternatives to Herbicides presented by Melanie Bondera. Total attendance was 45 people, and cash donations came out to \$41.25.

The August CSL program was Drought Resistant Plants presented by Bob Zeller and his associate. Total attendance was 33 people, and cash donations totaled \$23.00.

The September 23rd CSL program will be about Aquaponics by Vernon Byrd.

Diana has been doing an excellent job as the CSL Coordinator:

- She has four volunteers (whom I have named the “Seed Sisters”) who meet with her on Tuesdays in the work room to update the seed catalog in the lobby and process new member forms. Recently Diana bought a batch of new seeds (herbs, green beans, beets, cucumbers, lettuce, tomato, pumpkin, and more...)to update the drawers. There have been seed donations as well, some were dried/processed locally, others were packets bought in stores.
- Diana is working with two women to present October 28th for the CSL 2nd anniversary. Most likely there will be a short discussion forum in the library for the first part of the program, and then a hands-on demonstration of seed gathering on the lanai afterwards.
- Diana has made contact for more presenters in early 2018.

For our third CSL year, we will work on getting about 10-12 presenters, and continue holding the anniversary program in October. Thank you to all the FOLK Board members for their continual support!
