It's a game of cooperative storytelling, led by the Dungeon Master who weaves a story filled with excitement and danger. Players craft characters with unique strengths and must work together to succeed against all odds. Dungeon Master, Bryce Pierson, will be teaching and guiding the sessions. He has been playing D&D and other games for over 15 years, and has led D&D games for large groups at conventions.
