The Hawaii State Public Library System (HSPLS) is excited to welcome library patrons back into public libraries statewide for Wiki Visits starting November 15th! Wiki Visits will allow a limited number of patrons into the library for quick grab and go trips to select books and materials and for [Computer Time](#) at the library.

How do Wiki Visits work?

- Wiki visits start at the top of the hour and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis
- A limited number of library patrons will have up to 45 minutes to find books and materials, ask for assistance, use copiers or use a computer
- Library patrons are limited to one Wiki Visit per day
- Newspapers, magazines and reading areas inside the library are not available yet

Everyone entering the public libraries will be required to follow mandated health and safety protocols at all times while inside the library. Visits are limited in compliance with public health guidance to reduce exposure for all and to allow for proper disinfection of all high touch areas.

All public libraries will continue to offer [Library Take Out](#) services for library patrons that want to continue making appointments to pick up their books and materials. Public libraries will also continue providing free wifi zones outside all library buildings for everyone who needs free access to the internet.
